Code of Conduct

This code of conduct is relevant to both players and teams and by registering with the GBFF both the teams and players agree to adhere to all points herein.

- ❑ All players are reminded that they do NOT play Floorball or any other ball games in any part of the sports centres other than the hall which we have hired. Any player seen to be breaching this, after having been reminded of this rule by any member of the GBFF committee will be charged a fine of £5 payable by the team prior to participation in future tournaments/events for each offence.
- ❑ Any player seen to be playing without the relevant membership or correctly filled out and signed parental consent form, where required will be removed for that game and until such measures are resolved
- ❑ All teams will have correctly numbered shirts for all games. IFF rules shall apply
- ❑ Any team that turns up late for their game, or for refereeing and scribing duties resulting in a delay on that pitch can be subject to a £5.00 fine.
- ❑ All breaches of this code of conduct will be recorded by the relevant member of the GBFF committee. There is a time limit of all fines which will be paid within 1 month of being handed out. Any fines that are not paid within this time frame will result in a 2 point reduction for the team to which the player is registered.
- ❑ At every tournament it is the responsibility of the first teams playing of ensuring the rink and all markings are in place, the last teams of the day are responsible for ensuring the rink is taken down and returned to the relevant place. All GBFF members also present are to help these teams in their tasks.
- ❑ No person is to play on any area of the sports hall until The rink/ rinks are completely ready for the first games
- ❑ All comments and complaints regarding GBFF events should be emailed to the General Secretary (see the GBFF website for the Address). No player or other person is to directly contact anyone involved in the dispute.
Any comments will be acknowledged and recorded by the GBFF/League representative present.
- ❑ The GBFF will not accept
 - ❑ **Intimidating, aggressive or abusive behaviour of any kind, particularly towards referees**
 - ❑ **Foul language of any kind either on the pitch or amongst spectators**
 - ❑ Teams neglecting to remove all rubbish from meeting points and benches after games

Any team or individual player seen to not be adhering to these rules could be liable to pay fines at the discretion of GBFF committee

- ❑ A refereeing schedule will be produced in advance of each tournament by the refereeing committee and will be communicated to the teams via the GBFF league co-ordinators, all teams are required to provide two qualified referees throughout the league season. Those referees selected by the referee committee to officiate any match must attend accompanied by minimum two scribes in advance of the game.
Inability to attend must be communicated at least 48 hours in advance to the GBFF refereeing committee.
Failure to do so will result in a fine determined by the referee committee which is payable prior to the teams next match.
